When you are far away from a sound source the sound is quieter


6-Sound source


Everything around us is made from material. Objects might be made from:








11-Changing materials

Soil is made of bits of rock, living things and living things that have died. You can find soil if you dig a hole. You can find soil in a plant pot.






13-Earth
