Common and Proper Nouns.

Common noun is a name of a person, place, animal, thing
It's a general noun. It doesn't start with a capital letter.

Ex. Sister, school, rabbit, desk

Proper noun is a name of a specific person, place, animal,
Thing

It's a specific noun.

It starts with a capital letter.

Ex. Amjad, Cairo Festival Mall, Fluffy, Faber Castle Pencil
