The four types of communication

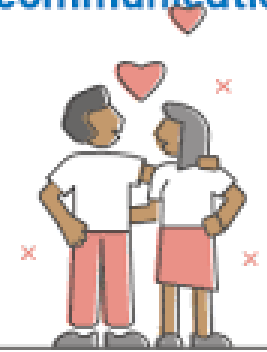
- Verbal

Verbal Communication



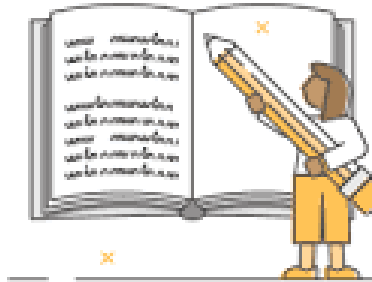
Using spoken language to convey a message

Non-verbal communication



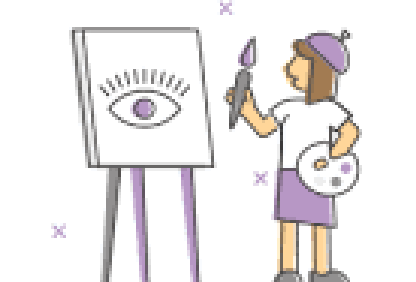
Using body language to convey a message

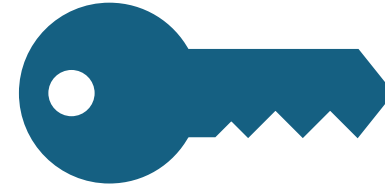

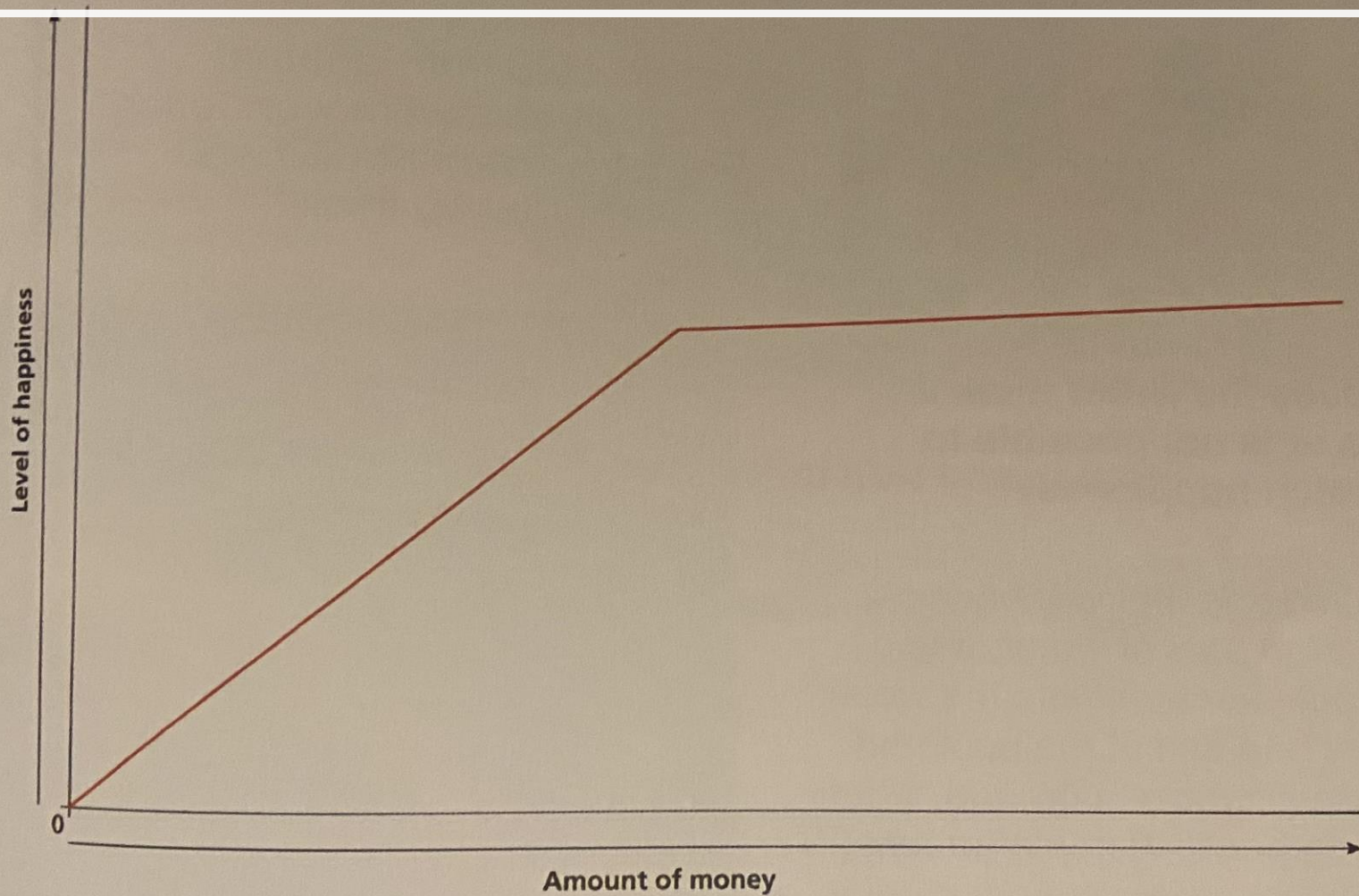
