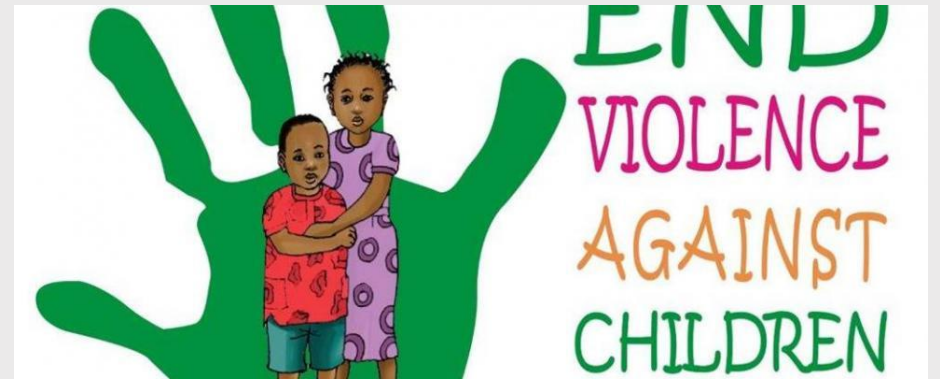

Protection from violence

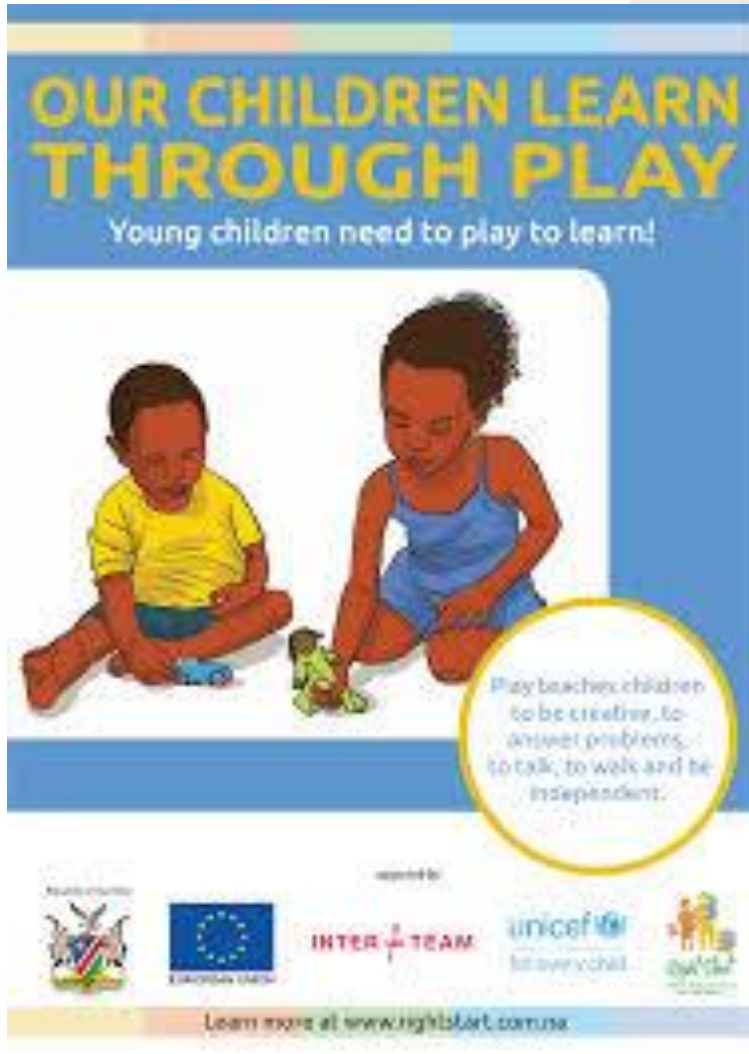


Violence against children is a serious problem around the world, and organizations like UNICEF are working diligently to protect children and ensure their safety.

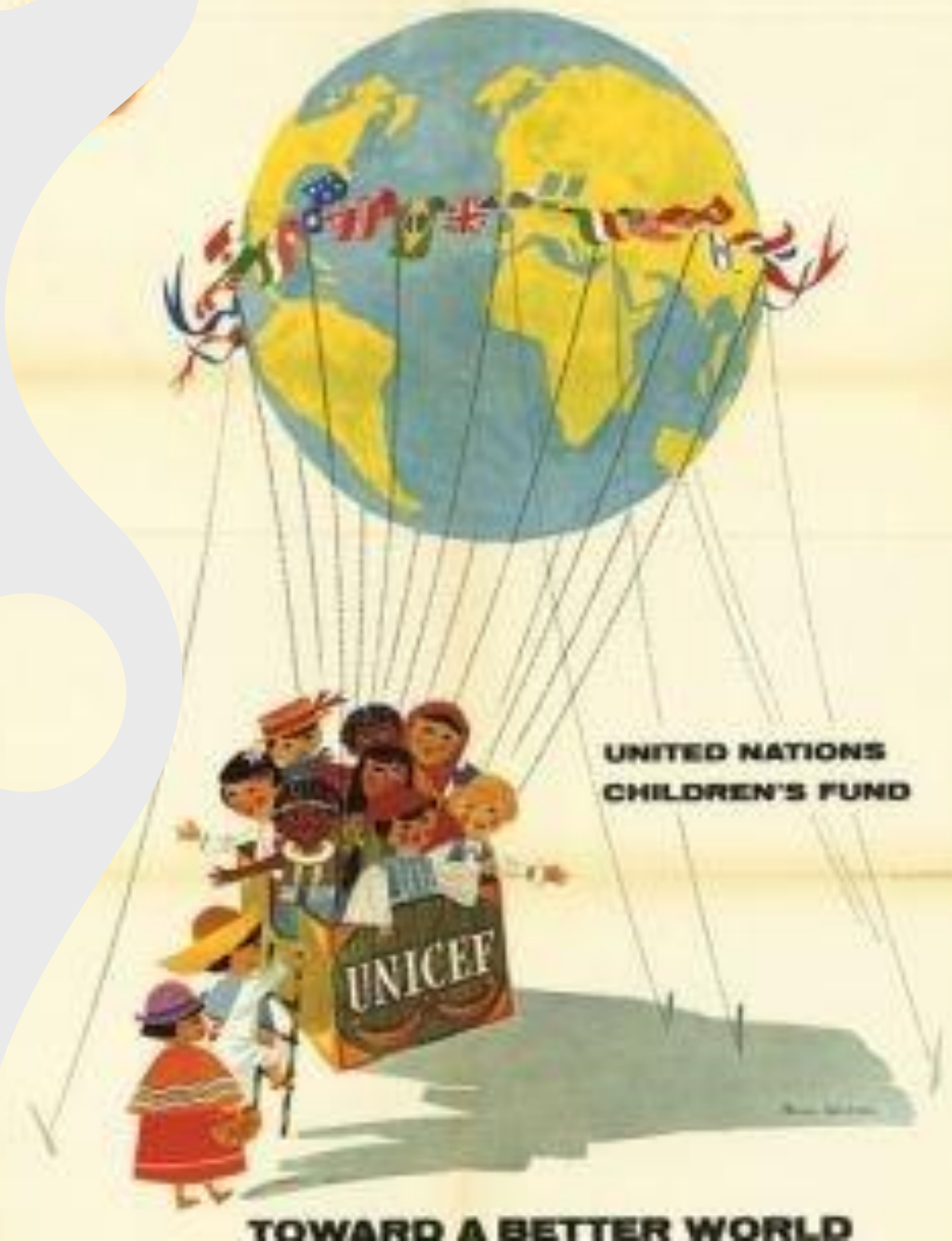
It allows them to explore their creativity, problem-solving abilities, and imagination. Play also fosters emotional development, helping children express and regulate their emotions.
