Inuit people

- The Inuit People are Native to the Arctic regions of Alaska, Canada, and Greenland.
- They have a rich culture that has been shaped by their environment. The Inuit are known for their igloos, which are dome-shaped houses made of ice and snow.
- They are skilled hunters and fishermen, relying on the land and sea for food.
- Traditionally, the Inuit have a deep connection to nature and believe in living in harmony with the environment.
- Today, many Inuit communities still maintain their traditions and way of life, preserving their unique heritage for future generations.

IGLOOS

Igloos are traditional winter homes built by the Inuit people of the Arctic.

To build an igloo you need blocks of hard-packed snow.

These snow blocks are carefully cut

As the blocks are placed, the builder angles them slightly inward to create a dome shape.

The snow blocks are then connected using a mixture of snow and ice,

This provides warmth and protection from the harsh Arctic elements
