2(a)(i)	<p><b><u>Identify a word or phrase from the text</u> which suggests the same idea as the <u>words underlined</u>:</b></p> <p><b>Natalia was expecting the quietness of their walk to be <u>broken suddenly</u>.</b></p> <p>(I assumed the silence of our walk would be) <i>shattered</i> (lines 1–2) (1)</p>	1
2(a)(ii)	<p><b><u>Identify a word or phrase from the text</u> which suggests the same idea as the <u>words underlined</u>:</b></p> <p><b>Natalia <u>slowed herself down and made herself as tall as possible</u> before refusing to go any further.</b></p> <p><i>drew myself up</i> (and stopped) (line 8) (1)</p>	1
2(a)(iii)	<p><b><u>Identify a word or phrase from the text</u> which suggests the same idea as the <u>words underlined</u>:</b></p> <p><b>Her grandfather <u>spoke to her in a low, angry voice</u>.</b></p> <p>(he) <i>hissed</i> (line 9) (1)</p>	1
2(a)(iv)	<p><b><u>Identify a word or phrase from the text</u> which suggests the same idea as the <u>words underlined</u>:</b></p> <p><b>The homeless person was <u>fast asleep</u>.</b></p> <p><i>sleeping</i> (so) <i>soundly</i> (that I would have thought him dead) (line 13) (1)</p>	1
2(b)(i)	<p><b><u>Using your own words</u>, explain what the writer means by each of the <u>words underlined</u>:</b></p> <p><b>peered</b></p> <p>peered: look intently (ahead), stare (ahead), try to see (ahead) (accept any appropriate synonym) (1)</p>	1
2(b)(ii)	<p><b><u>Using your own words</u>, explain what the writer means by each of the <u>words underlined</u>:</b></p> <p><b>dying</b></p> <p>dying: fading (light), becoming fainter and fainter, about to go out, dimming (light) (accept any appropriate synonym) (1)</p>	1
2(b)(iii)	<p><b><u>Using your own words</u>, explain what the writer means by each of the <u>words underlined</u>:</b></p> <p><b>enormous</b></p> <p>enormous: huge, massive (accept any appropriate synonym – do not accept ‘big’ alone) (1)</p>	1
